Public School Policy Summary

Admission & Enrollment

Enrollment is open for Kindergarten and 1st Grade for the 2026-2027 school year. Seats are limited. Admission is based on application review, available space, required documents, parent agreement, and school approval.

Kindergarten Readiness

Children entering Kindergarten should be 5 years old on or before August 15. Children who turn 5 after August 15 and on or before September 30 may be considered through the school readiness review process, when available.

Attendance

Students are expected to attend school regularly and arrive on time. Parents should notify the school when a student is absent or late. Excessive absences or tardies may require a parent conference and attendance plan.

Health & Immunization

Families must provide health and immunization records or exemption documentation as required by school policy. Parents must inform the school of allergies, medications, medical conditions, or emergency care needs.

Arrival, Dismissal & Pickup

Students may only be released to parents/guardians or authorized adults listed by the family. Parents must keep emergency contacts and pickup information current.



Student Conduct

Students are expected to show respect, honesty, kindness, good manners, Islamic character, and obedience to school rules. Bullying, unsafe behavior, disrespect, or repeated disruption may result in parent conference and disciplinary action.

Uniform & Modesty

Students are expected to follow the school uniform and modesty guidelines. Uniforms promote unity, discipline, modesty, and school identity.

Tuition & Scholarship Support

The masjid is determined to raise funds and scholarships to cover a major portion of tuition costs when possible. Parents are expected to cover the remaining family balance after scholarship/fundraising support is determined.

Parent Partnership

Parents are expected to support school rules, communicate respectfully, submit documents on time, attend required meetings, and help students succeed academically and Islamically.
